

Young Professional Board Member Responsibilities

Candidates who have been recommended as prospective members of the young professional's board should be comfortable with, and be able to do the following:

- Become knowledgeable about child abuse and the various forms of child maltreatment. Understand the purpose of Child Enrichment programs and how child victims of trauma can recover.
- Serve as an ambassador for the organization and inform others about the work, mission and volunteer opportunities available to them and others through Child Enrichment's programs
- Participate in the planning and execution of Heroes for Hope 5k in October every year
- Participate in the planning and execution of April Prevention Month awareness activities
- Participation in the Annual Campaign, via a personal financial donation
- Cooperative participation in Board Meetings, committee meetings, and in general work providing advice for the organization
- Assist the governing board to overcome obstacles by offering a fresh perspective, introducing new technology and appealing to younger generations
- Sell or purchase 4 tickets to the Cookin' For Kids Oyster Roast

Requirements:

- Submission of a criminal background check through a local law enforcement office which is clear of felony convictions, and clear of offenses against children and others
- Ability to attend the 11 Board Meetings each year, which are held the 2nd Thursday of each month at 4 p.m. Board Meeting attendance is critically important to the organization being able to conduct business consistently and efficiently
